Loïc Bonnet, founder of the world's leading charter company, Dream Yacht Charter, said: "We are approaching our 20th anniversary next year since the company's foundation. "It is clear that sailing vacations have changed a great deal in the last twenty years. In the Mediterranean, we will have an additional 35 catamarans and 48 monohulls for customers to choose from. We've already scheduled 195 yachts for delivering in 2020 with even more planned.

- Stavanger, Norway





OUR HISTORY



In the next three years, Dream Yacht Charter launched in the Bahamas, Annapolis, Antigua and expanded in the Grenadines. Since then, Bali, Mexico, Puerto Rico, Spain, Italy, Sweden and Montenegro have joined our list of exciting destinations.

We pioneered by the cabin charters with guaranteed departures and we now offer 25+ routes across 15+ destinations. We strive for constant innovation, bringing new sailing grounds to market, such as New Caledonia and Cuba. We've also introduced six ownership programs for potential yacht owners who want flexible options that suit their objectives. We offer the lowest entry price on the market.
